“PRESS RELEASE”

The Disciplinary Hearing of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) concerning athlete Mr. Nesta Carter was held on Monday, October 17, 2016 at its headquarters in Lausanne, Switzerland at 8:30 a.m.

This Hearing arose as a consequence of an adverse analytical finding from the re-testing of Beijing 2008 samples requested by the IOC and in accordance with the 8 years storage provision in the participation rules applicable to the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games.

The Disciplinary Panel appointed by the IOC consisted of three members from their Executive Board:

Presentations were made on behalf of the IOC and Counsel for Mr. Carter, and several papers and documents were tendered in evidence by both parties. The Hearing concluded at approximately 1:50 p.m. and the Chairman advised that the Panel would consider the matter, and the parties would be advised of their findings in due course.
